Programs include Nutrition Knights school and community food pantries, Long Beach Food Pantry Delivery, Benefits Enrollment Services, as well as Wellness Education and Resources.


Prior to HMHY, Ms. Washington was the President of the Watts Charity Association, dedicated to providing cancer awareness and prevention by promoting the importance of early detection through screening and testing, as well as proper nutrition and exercise. Throughout her career, Ms. Washington has also been passionate about helping youth. This is evidenced through her years of success while working for a family service nonprofit organization in Kern County to help transition foster care children.

Over the last 8 years, Ms. Washington shared her extensive experience, business acumen, and passion via her consulting company that benefited Los Angeles business owners and nonprofits by coaching them on how to grow and sustain successful businesses.
